Network Number and Network Identifier for Mobile Number Portability

Purpose

This paper reports the results of allocation of the Network Numbers (NNs) and the Network Identifiers (NIs) to mobile network operators for the implementation of Mobile Number Portability (MNP).

Allocations of NI and NN

2. Number levels “148-149” and “48-49” have been reserved in the numbering plan as NI and NN respectively to mobile network operators for their implementation of MNP. A ballot exercise was held by the Office of the Telecommunications Authority (OFTA) on 14 July 1998 for purpose of allocating the NIs and NNs to mobile network operators. The ballot results are as follows :
