(Special Condition 4)

To : Hong Kong Cable Television Limited

Date : 1 June 2005

Pursuant to Special Condition 4 of the Fixed Carrier Licence converted on 1 June 2005 from Fixed Telecommunication Network Services Licence issued on 18 January 2000 to Hong Kong Cable Television Limited (HKCTV), the Telecommunications Authority hereby directs HKCTV, until further notice is given in writing, to facilitate the portability of numbers for customers of fixed telecommunications network services licensed under the fixed telecommunications network services licences or fixed carrier licences in Hong Kong (“Operator Number Portability”) so that HKTA 2102 entitled “Procedures for Handling Number Porting by Database Solution” issued by the Telecommunications Authority and other relevant documents as referred to in HKTA 2102 and as revised from time to time by the Telecommunications Authority can be fully complied with on and after the launch of the service. All relevant costs associated with providing portability of numbers under this Direction will be equitably shared between the licensee, any other fixed carrier or fixed telecommunications network services licensee.

Date : 1 June 2005

Pursuant to Special Condition 4 of the Fixed Carrier Licence converted on 1 June 2005 from Fixed Telecommunication Network Services Licence issued on 18 January 2000 to Hong Kong Cable Television Limited (HKCTV), the Telecommunications Authority hereby directs HKCTV, until further notice is given in writing, to facilitate, at HKCTV's own expenses, the portability of numbers for customers of public mobile radiotelephone services and personal communications services licensed under public radiocommunications service licences or mobile carrier licences in Hong Kong ("Mobile Number Portability") so that the Code of Practice entitled "Code of Practice related to the Implementation of Mobile Number Portability" issued by the Telecommunications Authority and as revised from time to time by the Telecommunications Authority can be fully complied with on and after the launch of the service.

(Special Condition 24.1)

To : Hong Kong Cable Television Limited
Date : 1 June 2005

The Telecommunications Authority having formed the opinion that Hong Kong Cable Television Limited (“HKCTV”) is not in a dominant position with respect to the markets for telephony services and wholesale broadband conveyance services, the Telecommunications Authority hereby directs that, pursuant to Special Condition 24.1 of the Fixed Carrier Licence converted on 1 June 2005 from Fixed Telecommunication Network Services Licence issued on 18 January 2000 to Hong Kong Cable Television Limited (HKCTV) (“the Licence”), from this date, until further notice is given, the following provisions of the General Conditions do not apply to HKCTV in relation to its provision of telephony services and cable modem access line service, under the Licence:

- (1) Special Condition 7.4;
- (2) Special Condition 8;
- (3) Special Condition 9; and
- (4) Special Condition 10.

The TA notes that in forming the opinion to which this direction relates, consideration has not been given to the application of sections 7K, 7L and 7N of the Telecommunications Ordinance in relation to any conduct by HKCTV or any other party, arising out of the provision of services the subject of the Licence or otherwise.
