**FIXED TELECOMMUNICATIONS NETWORK SERVICE LICENCE**

**DIRECTION**  
**(General Condition 14)**

To : Hutchison Global Communications Limited

Date : 16 April 2004

Pursuant to General Condition 14 of the licence issued on 30 June 1995, the Telecommunications Authority hereby directs Hutchison Global Communications Limited, until further notice is given in writing, to facilitate the portability of numbers for customers of fixed telecommunications network services licensed under the fixed telecommunications network services licences or fixed carrier licences in Hong Kong (“Operator Number Portability”) so that HKTA 2102 entitled “Procedures for Handling Number Porting by Database Solution” issued and other relevant documents as referred to in HKTA 2102 and as revised from time to time by the Telecommunications Authority can be fully complied with on and after the launch of the service.

This Direction supersedes all the Directions previously issued under General Condition 14 of the Fixed Telecommunications Network Services Licence.

**(Section 32F(4) (c) of the Telecommunications Ordinance)**

To : Hutchison Global Communications Limited

Pursuant to Section 32F(4) (c) of the Telecommunications Ordinance and the Fixed Telecommunications Networks Licence issued on 30 June 1995, the Telecommunications Authority hereby directs Hutchison Global Communications Limited, until further notice is given in writing, to facilitate the portability of numbers for customers of public mobile radiotelephone services and personal communications services licensed under public radiocommunications service licences or mobile carrier licences in Hong Kong (“Mobile Number Portability”) so that the Code of Practice entitled “Code of Practice related to the Implementation of Mobile Number Portability” issued and as revised from time to time by the Telecommunications Authority can be fully complied with on and after the launch of the service.

This Direction supersedes all the Directions previously issued under Section 3 of the Telephone Ordinance.

**(General Condition 44)**

To : Hutchison Global Communications Limited

The Telecommunications Authority now forms the opinion that Hutchison Global Communications Limited (HGC) is not in a dominant position with respect to any market for telecommunications services provided under its licence within the meaning of General Condition 16(2). Pursuant to General Condition 44 of the licence issued on 30 June 1995, the Telecommunications Authority hereby directs HGC, until further notice is given in writing, the General Conditions or any part thereof which impose the following obligations shall not apply to HGC.

Those parts of General Condition 17 which impose the obligation to implement Separations Accounting Practices as specified in Part 3 of the Accounting Manual issued and as revised from time to time by the Telecommunications Authority;

General Condition 21;

General Condition 22; and

General Condition 23.

This Direction supersedes all the Directions previously issued under General Condition 44 of the Fixed Telecommunications Network Services Licence.
