The Telecommunications Authority now forms the opinion that China Unicom International Limited (CUIL) is not in a dominant position with respect to any market for telecommunications services provided under its licence within the meaning of section 7L(2) Telecommunications Ordinance (Chapter 106). Pursuant to Special Condition 24.1 of the licence converted on 11 September 2003 from FTNS Licence issue on 18 October 2000 to CUIL, the Telecommunications Authority hereby directs CUIL, until further notice is given in writing, the Special Conditions or any part thereof which impose the following obligations shall not apply to CUIL:

- (1) Special Condition 7.4;
- (2) Special Condition 8;
- (3) Special Condition 9; and
- (4) Special Condition 10.

Pursuant to Special Condition 4 of the Fixed Carrier Licence issued on 11 September 2003, the Telecommunications Authority hereby directs China Unicom International Limited, until further notice is given in writing, to facilitate the portability of numbers for customers of fixed telecommunications network services licensed under the fixed telecommunications network services licences or fixed carrier licences in Hong Kong (“Operator Number Portability”) so that HKTA 2102 entitled “Procedures for Handling Number Porting by Database Solution” issued and other relevant documents as referred to in HKTA 2102 and as revised from time to time by the Telecommunications Authority can be fully complied with on and after the launch of the service.

This Direction supersedes all the Directions previously issued under Special Condition 4 of the Fixed Carrier Licence.

Pursuant to Special Condition 4 of the Fixed Carrier Licence issued on 11 September 2003, the Telecommunications Authority hereby directs China Unicom International Limited, until further notice is given in writing, to facilitate the portability of numbers for customers of public mobile radiotelephone services and personal communications services licensed under public radiocommunications service licences or mobile carrier licences in Hong Kong (“Mobile Number Portability”) so that the Code of Practice entitled “Code of Practice related to the Implementation of Mobile Number Portability” issued and as revised from time to time by the Telecommunications Authority can be fully complied with on and after the launch of the service.

This Direction supersedes all the Directions previously issued under Special Condition 4 of the Fixed Carrier Licence.
