

**TELECOMMUNICATIONS ORDINANCE**  
**(Chapter 106)**

**FIXED CARRIER LICENCE**

**WAIVER AND DIRECTION**  
**(Special Condition 27)**

To : Hong Kong Cable Television Limited  
Date : 1 June 2005

Having considered that Hong Kong Cable Television Limited (the “licensee”) has committed to adopt DOCSIS open technical standards in 1.6 million Premises Passed by the service and the network by the end of December 2005 and has undertaken to migrate the service and the network to open technical standards by 1 June 2010 under Special Condition 27.2, the Telecommunications Authority (the “Authority), in accordance with Special Condition 27.1 of the Fixed Carrier Licence (the “Licence”) converted on 1 June 2005 from Fixed Telecommunication Network Services Licence issued on 18 January 2000 to the licensee, hereby waives the obligation of the licensee to adopt the technical standards required under Special Condition 27.1 for the customer premises equipment, namely “cable modem” connected to the Network until 1 June 2010.

Pursuant to Special Condition 27.2, the Authority directs that the licensee shall migrate the service and the network, at its own expense, to a technical standard which comply with the requirement under Special Condition 27.1 by 1 June 2010 and the disruption to customer service shall be minimised during the migration.

This Waiver and Direction supersedes all the waivers and directions previously issued under Special Condition 3 of the Fixed Telecommunications Network Services Licence granted to the licensee 18 January 2000.
